### ○ Guides and porters

- **½ day activity:** Guides and porters are picked from the reception before 9 am and returned to the same reception (where possible) within 5 hours.
- **Full day activity:** Guides and porters are picked up from reception 9:00 am. unless the guide is returned before midday.
- Additional fee of 15,000 rwf is applied for the guides and porter's accommodation and food for up to 3 nights on multi-day walking trails,
- Any supplement nights will command a top up of 5,000 Rwf per extra night.
- **Tourist-Guide ratio:** 8 tourists per guide to ensure safety of guests but also ensure the information shared by the guide can be absorbed and heard by all.

### ○ Park Entry Fee

- The entry fee covers all nature walk trails including waterfalls, except trails that take more than one day.
- The entry fee is payable by all day visitors as well as by overnight visitors.
- The fee reduces by 50% for the second and third nights, and then free for any subsequent nights for up to one week
- Visitors staying outside the park are considered 'day visitors' (unless staying in approved hospitality entity that the park has a signed agreement with) and will be required to pay the entry fee for the day they enter the park.

---

- **Children**

- **5 years and below:** Free of charge
- . Between 6 and 12 Years old: Activity fees rate for children apply
- 13 years-old and above: Pay adult rates for entry fees and activities.

- **Nationals and Resident in Rwanda/EAC**

- **Residency status:** To be verified with documentation, or international visitor fees may be charged.
- **Groups discount:** 20% discount off the normal entry fee of more than 20 people or both nationals and residents.

- **Night walks**

- **Night walks:** from 5:30 PM to 8 or 9:00 PM. Guides are available at the designated reception.
- Specialized head lamps and torches are offered at the reception.

- **Cyinzobe 3-day Hiking Trail**

- Starts from Uwinka Visitor Centre at 01:00PM with 3 people minimum and 10 maximum and ends around 12:00 at Gisakura reception depending on each one's pace.
- It allows hikers to enjoy the magnificent view of Kamiranzovu swamp and its waterfall along the park's west boundary.
- **Distance to Hike:** 8km first day from Uwinka Reception to the first A-frame wooden cabin where you spend a night (elevation from 2420m to 2328 m a.s.l). each camping site has 5 wooden cabins and by default each cabin can host two people maximum. A couple can join two single beds together. 11 km second day from the first camping site to the second (elevation from 2328 m to 1812 m a.s.l); and 6 km third day (elevation from 1812m to 1933 a.s.l).

- **Chimpanzee Habituation Experience (CHE)**

- **Location:** Gisovu Chimpanzee Community, norther part of the park
- **Accommodation:** Gisovu Guest house offers two cottages of 11 single beds including breakfast.
- **Activity:** CHE is about spending full day with trackers and Chimpanzees while studying behavior, fruiting patterns, diet and data recording while they are in their natural habitat. Guests de-nest(experiencing chimps leaving their nest) and nest( experiencing chimps making their nests) them. They also participate, together with tracker, identify chimps based on individual features.

- **Level of difficulty**

- Generally, hiking in Nyungwe National Park requires a certain level of physical fitness when you look at the elevation: 1600-2950m ABSL.
- **Difficult:** Most full and multi-day trails are at this level: Imbaraga trail, Uwinka trail, Kamiranzovu waterfall, Bigugu trail, Rukuzi trail, Cyinzove 3-day Hiking trail, Congo Nile Divide Trail, Chimps tracking, chimp's habituation experience

- **Moderate:** Umuyove trail, Ndamabare trail, Irebero, Kamiranzovu trail, Umugote trail, Night walks, birdwatching, canopy walkway.
  - **Easy:** Buhoro trail, Igishigishigi trail.
    - **Annual pass**
      - **Annual pass:** Single, couple and family passes are offered.
      - It includes entry permits except park special activities.
      - 10% discount on park activities.
      - Further terms and conditions apply- please read them carefully before purchasing a pass.
        - **Tents and other camping equipment**
          - Tent hire does not include any bedding or camping equipment.
          - You can bring your own camping equipment. Food and beverages are sold at the park coffee shops.
        - **Mode of payment**
          - Cash is not accepted.
          - Visa cards, Mobile Money, DirectPay Online, and bank transfers are accepted.
        - **Cancellation & Refund policy:**
          - Cancellations are required to be in writing and incur the following charges:
            - ✓ more than 30 days prior to arrival, the client is charged 0% of the total amount due
            - ✓ more than 7 days prior to arrival, the client is charged 30% of the total amount due
            - ✓ less than 7 days prior to arrival, the client is charged 50% of the total amount due
            - ✓ after the activity was due to have commenced, the client is charged 100% of the total amount due
