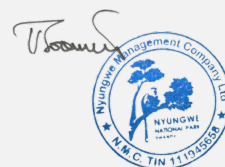

## Park Entry Fee:

- The entry fee covers all nature walk trails including waterfalls, except trails that take more than one day.
- The entry fee is payable by all day and overnight visitors.
- The fee reduces by 50% for the second and third nights, and then free for any subsequent nights for up to a week.
- Visitors staying outside the Park are considered “day visitors” (unless staying in an approved hospitality entity that the Park has signed agreement with) and will be required to pay the entry fee for the day they enter the Park.

## ADDITIONAL NOTES

### Guides and Porters:

- **Half day activity:** Guides and porters are picked from the reception before 09:00am and returned to the same reception (where possible) within 5 hours.
- **Full day activity:** Guides and porters are picked from the reception before 09:00am unless the guide is returned before mid-day.
- An additional fee of RWF15,000 is applied for the guides and porter's accommodation and food for up to 3 nights on multi-day walking trails.
- Any supplement nights will command a top up of RWF5,000 per extra night.
- **Maximum number of visitors:** A maximum of 8 visitors per guide are permitted to ensure the safety of guests and the information shared by the guide can be absorbed and heard by all.

## ADDITIONAL NOTES

### Children:

- **5 years and below:** Free of charge.
- **Between 6 and 12 years old:** Only park entry fee rates apply.
- **13 years and older:** Adult rates apply.

### Residents and citizens of Rwanda:

- Residency status: To be verified with documentation, or international visitor fees will apply.
- Group discount: 20% discount off normal entry fee of more than 20 people or both nationals and residents.

### Night walks:

- Night walks: from 5:30pm to 8:00pm or 9:00pm. Guides are available at the designated reception areas.
- Specialized head lamps and torches are offered at the reception.

### Cyinzobe 3-day hiking trail:

- Starts from Uwinka Visitor Centre at 1:00pm with a minimum of 3 and maximum of 10 people and ends approximately 12:00 at Gisakura reception depending on each person's walking pace.
- It allows hikers to enjoy the magnificent view of Kamiranzovu swamp and its waterfall along the park's west boundary.
- Distance: The first day from Uwinka Reception to the first A-frame wooden cabin where you spend the first night (elevation from 2420m to 2328m a.s.l) is an 8km walk. Each camping site has 5 wooden cabins and by default each cabin can host two people maximum. A couple can move two single beds together. The second day from the first camping site to the second (elevation from 2328m to 1812m a.s.l) is a 11km walk. The third day is a 6km walk (elevation 1812m to 1933m a.s.l).

### Chimpanzee Habituation Experience (CHE):

- Location: Gisovu Chimpanzee Community is at the northern part of the Park.
- Accommodation: Gisovu Guest House offer two cottages of 11 single beds. Breakfast is not included.
- Activity: Spend the full day with trackers and Chimpanzees while studying their behaviour, fruiting patterns, diet and data recording while they are in their natural habitat. Visitors de-nest (experience chimps leaving their nest) and nest (chimps making their nests) them. Visitors also participate with tracker to identify chimps based on their individual features.

### Level of difficulty

- Hiking in Nyungwe National Park requires a certain level of physical fitness when you consider the elevation of 1600m-2950m ASL.
- **Difficult:** Most full and multi-day trails are at this level: Imbaraga Trail, Uwinka Trail, Kamiranzovu Waterfall, Bigugu Trail, Rukuzi Trail, Cyinzobe 3-day Hiking Trail, Congo Nile Divide Trail, Chimps Tracking and Chimp's Habituation Experience.
- **Moderate:** Umuyove Trail, Ndamabare Trail, Irebero, Kamiranzovu Trail, Umugote Trail, Night Walks, Birdwatching, Canopy Walkway.
- **Easy:** Buhoro Trail, Igishigishigi Trail.

### Annual Pass:

- Annual Pass: Single, Couple and family passes are offered.
- The passes include entry permits except park activities.
- Visitors qualify for a 10% discount on park activities.
- Further terms and conditions apply. Please read these carefully before purchasing a pass.

# General reservation's & cancellation policy

## GENERAL INFORMATION

At the time of reservation confirmation, the following details are required:

- Nationality of guest(s), tour operator/group and contact information;
- Travel details including mode of transport and arrival/departure date and times;
- Special dietary needs must be communicated at the time of booking to ensure proper arrangements.

## RESERVATIONS

Provisional reservations will be held for a period of 14 days where after it needs to be confirmed, or it will automatically release. Provisional reservations are not accepted during peak season (June – September).

A 25% deposit is required to confirm a reservation. Full and final payment is due 45 days prior to arrival. Payment can be done via bank transfer, DPO, MoMo, visa & master card. Bank fees are for guest or tour operator's account.

The standard terms and conditions apply once booking is confirmed.

## CANCELLATION TERMS

More than 45 days prior to arrival:	25% cancellation fee
30 – 45 days prior to arrival:	50% cancellation fee

## CONSENT

The person making any reservation warrants that he or she has authority to enter into a contract on behalf of the other person/s included in such a reservation and in the event of the failure of any or all of the other persons so included to make payment, the person making the reservation shall by his/her signature thereof assume personal liability for the total price of all reservations made by him/her.

The payment of the deposit or any other partial payment for a reservation on a safari constitutes consent by all Travellers covered by that payment to all provisions of the conditions and general information contained in our brochure and/or website whether the Traveller has signed the reservation form or not. The terms under which the Traveller agrees to these safaris cannot be changed or amended except in writing signed by an authorized director of the Organisation.

## PAYMENT TERMS

All prices quoted exclude any financial transaction charges or rate of exchange fluctuations. Such costs are for traveler's account. All payments must be made in the currency quoted and by wire transfer, EFT or credit card. Upon payment, please email a copy of the Proof of Payment to the reservationist. This information is required to confirm the reservation.

We reserve the right to review published rates at any time in response to exchange rate fluctuations, increases in taxes or any operating costs beyond our control.

We reserve the right to revisit payment and cancellation terms listed in the published rate sheet in the event of radical changes in market demand for the property.

## RISKS

The traveler understands that there are dangers, hazards and risks (Risks) inherent and associated with safari activities and other services provided by the Organization on tour, which may be present at any time before, during and after the traveler's tour, including but not limited to encounters with wild animals, fire, transportation accidents, flash floods, and random Acts of God.

Whilst the Organization will take reasonable steps to ensure that the safari and other services provided are of an acceptable standard, the traveler acknowledges and voluntarily accepts and assumes any and all responsibility for all Risks and agrees to the indemnity and limitation of liability below, which shall apply except if the Organization is found to be negligent in relation to the traveler's participation in the safari or provision of services.

## LIABILITY & INDEMNITY

In the event that the Organization books third party properties on behalf of a traveler, then in such a role Organization serves purely as a reservation's agent for the third part property and assumes no liability whatsoever for an injury, damage, loss, accident or delay to person or property. All reservations for these third-party properties and suppliers are also governed by African Parks' prevailing cancellation policies, terms and conditions unless otherwise noted at the time of confirmation.

## EXCLUSIONS

In the event of any safari being rendered impossible, illegal or inadvisable by weather, strike, war, government, pandemic or any other cause or interference whatsoever, the extra expenses incurred as a result thereof shall be the responsibility of the traveler.

Travelers will be charged directly by the relevant service providers for any emergency services they may require and may find themselves in a position unable to access such services should they not be carrying the relevant insurance cover.
